Reading/Writing

In guided reading groups, students are reading informational texts to gather background information about the Powhatan people, John Smith, and Pocahontas. We will be identifying the main idea as well as the key details which support the main idea. This information will aid students when writing their historical fiction story. By the end of the week, students will decide both the perspective and point of view from which they will be telling their story.
